Please read carefully and sign

We recommend a blood profile screening before anesthesia and surgery to ensure that your pet is in a low-risk category. Conditions which may influence the effect of anesthetic agents or medications on your pet may not be evident during the pre-surgical physical examination. These tests are similar to those that your own physician would run were you to undergo anesthesia; they evaluate the two organs responsible for metabolizing the anesthetic.

Additional Bloodwork Options (optional):

We can also run additional screenings to lower the risk of anesthesia even more. For \$96.60, we can run a complete blood count and extended profile that would provide an overall assessment of your pet. A complete blood count analyzes the individual cells to give us a more accurate picture of anemia, infection, hydration, clotting factors, parasites, and inflammation. The extended profile analyzes not only a more complete kidney, liver, and blood sugar evaluation, but also pancreas, protein, and electrolytes. Microchipping

The HomeAgain Pet Recovery Service (microchipping) is a safe, simple, and permanent form of pet identification designed to quickly identify lost pets and reunite them with their owners. It's a proven way to successfully recover your pet if it ever becomes lost. This can be done while your pet is under anesthesia.

Flea Treatment/Prevention

We offer the flea pill Capstar, a safe product that can be given orally to your pet to kill all adult fleas for a 24-hour period. If live fleas are noticed on your pet, we will always administer the Capstar tablet at your cost to avoid transfer of fleas to other patients and our hospital. You may also choose to have a Capstar pill given if you would like to prevent any adult fleas from possibly going home on your pet. If you prefer, we can apply a monthly flea product at an additional charge.

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E-collar (Cone or Inflatable)

An e-collar is a device used to keep your pet from licking (and doing damage to) their incision. We highly recommend an e-collar for every surgical patient. All e-collars are non-returnable and non-refundable. E-collars range in price from \$12.00 - \$27.50 depending on size.

Electrocautery Required for all declaws and mass removal procedures

We provide a technology known as electrocautery surgery. Electrocautery surgery passes an electric signal (similar to FM radio waves) through a fine wire to incise and cauterize tissue. This allows us to limit blood loss, while at the same time minimizing pain and swelling related to surgery. This technology is available to all surgeries at an additional \$30.00 charge.

Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation

Although we take every precaution to make sure that your pet's body can properly handle anesthesia, there is always a risk involved. We will always do everything in our power to make sure your pet wakes up safely. In case of emergency:

- Yes, please perform CPR on my pet until I can be reached. I agree to pay additional charges incurred by this process (starting at \$300.00)**
- No, please do NOT perform CPR on my pet. I understand that failing to choose CPR when necessary will likely cause heart failure and ultimately, death, and will not hold the doctors of staff of Seville Wadsworth Veterinary Clinic responsible for the outcome.**

I, the undersigned owner or agent of the owner of the pet identified, authorize the veterinarian(s) and staff at the Seville Wadsworth Veterinary Clinic to perform the above procedure(s). My signature on this form indicates that any questions I have regarding anesthesia, the estimate provided to me, or the above procedure(s) have been answered to my satisfaction. I understand that although all reasonable precautions and due care will be taken, there is always a potential risk with anesthesia and surgery. I accept these risks and authorize Seville Wadsworth Veterinary Clinic to perform such treatment as deemed necessary. I assume financial responsibility for all charges incurred to the patient.
